


Fitness Classes with Tracy

Universal Access Porch for the Biddeford Pool Community Center



A workable design that will allow the Center's first floor to become handicap accessible has been presented to the Board of Trustees. Fellow member Chris Carroll, who is an architect, offered his help. The deck he has designed will accommodate a chairlift with protection from the elements, is ADA compliant, and user friendly. Bids have been sent out to several local construction contractors with the hope of finding one that can begin work as soon as possible at a reasonable price.
